

2022 Tiny Tot Contest

The Old Miners Day Committee (OMD) and Miss Viburnum Committee (MVC) is excited to host the 2022 Tiny Tot Contest to be held on Saturday, October 1, 2022 at the Viburnum High School Gym. The Tiny Tot Contest will take place during the Miss Viburnum Pageant (more information to follow).

THE COMPETITION

The Tiny Tot Contest is for boys and girls ages 3-6 years old. All contestants must live within the Iron County C-4 School District. All entries must be received by Friday, September 9, 2022. A \$10 fee is required at the time of entry.

There will be a variety of ways for contestants to earn points including:

1. **Can decoration** - all participants will decorate 1 can to collect money.

Cans will be set up at G&W Foods for approximately 2 weeks. Cans will be judged by the Miss Viburnum judges based on overall appearance, creativity, and theme.

2. **Money collection** - in the past, participants with the most amount of money collected were the overall winner. While this will still play a part, it is not the only way contestants will be able to earn points.

Cans will still be the primary fundraiser for the Tiny Tot Contest. The more money we raise, the better/more prizes we can give!

3. **Old Miner's Day Parade** - Contestants may procure their own vehicle to ride in, or ride in the Miss Viburnum Float. If contestants do not participate in the parade, they will miss out on points!

The Parade will be Saturday, October 1, 2022 from approximately 11:00-1:00 pm. More information to follow.

4. **On-stage question** - All contestants will answer 1 on stage question.

Questions will be age appropriate and a list of possible questions will be provided 1 week prior to the contest.

5. **Drawing** - all contestants will be asked to draw a picture to be judged by the Miss Viburnum Judges.

The drawings will all be based on the same prompt; more information to follow!

6. **Talent** - this portion is optional, but strongly encouraged!

The Talent portion will not count toward the overall score. All talents must be approved by the MVC by September 23, 2022.
